

Each day has a selection of moderate, medium and challenging trails but, hopefully not necessarily vehicle damaging trail schedules.

OVER NIGHT TRAIL BEEF BASIN This trail has never been run before. It will climb to 8,250 feet and you will visit Indian ruins. Special things to consider: You will need to be self contained with food, water and fuel for this adventure. 335 miles total with 150 miles of pavement, (your vehicle must be able to sustain 55 mph on pavement.) Potluck dinner both nights – if you're interested, bring a side dish and an item for the Goulash pot – not mandatory.






2012 Campground Info


